

**NOTICE OF CORRECTED PROCESS
LAKELAND MUNICIPAL ELECTION
SEPTEMBER 20, 2007**

The City of Lakeland, Tennessee has clarified their election process for the September 20, 2007, election to include voting for three (3) Lakeland Commissioners rather than two (2) Lakeland Commissioners as stated in the ad published on Friday, August 24, 2007, in The Commercial Appeal. On May 3, 2007, the Lakeland Board of Commissioners passed and adopted Resolution 2007/05-37 establishing the process to be followed for filling a vacancy on their Board as follows:

In the Lakeland Municipal Election to be held on September 20, 2007, there will be two (2) Commissioners elected for regular four-year terms and one (1) Commissioner elected to fill the remaining two-year term of the vacant position. Candidates in the September 20, 2007, election for the Lakeland Board of Commissioners will receive terms as follows:

Four-year term: Candidate with the highest number of votes

Four-year term: Candidate with the second highest number of votes

Two-year term: Candidate with the third highest number of votes

This notice is an effort to educate and inform voters of the additional choice they have in the September 20, 2007, election. Following is an amended Sample Ballot for this election.
